## **Types of Assignments & Grading:**

**Participation:** 1-2 points. Assignments simply checked to see if they are completed. If it appears that the student made an honest effort, the student receives full credit.

**Homework:** 1-2 points. Typically started in class and finished outside of class. Based on notes. Can be redone any number of times for up to a 50%.

**Quizzes:** 1-3 points. **Computer** assignments. Based on notes. Can be redone any number of times until the due date. The highest grade earned of all attempts is the grade earned.

- By going to Quia.com and logging in, you can **always** check the grades on quizzes, and they **can be** worked on outside of school!

**Tests:** 10-15 points. These are pencil and paper exams taken in the classroom. Students should study, and be prepared to write. They can be redone **once** for up to an 80%.

**Projects:** <points vary> Activities which are collected and graded. Most often they cannot be redone. If they can be, it's for up to an 80%.

Overall grade = total points earned ÷ total points
